Job Summary: The Railroad Carpenter works within the Car Shop to perform interior and exterior wood repair/replacement on rolling stock. Work can include wood framing, sanding, staining, finishing along with electrical and plumbing repair.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Complete structural and finish carpentry work on all rolling stock to include doors, windows, trim, framing and siding
- Assist with installation/repair of plumbing, furnaces, generators, AC/DC electrical on passenger coaches
- Work with carmen to inspect cars, perform repairs and complete scheduled maintenance
- Other duties as assigned

Education, Skill and Work Experience Requirements:
